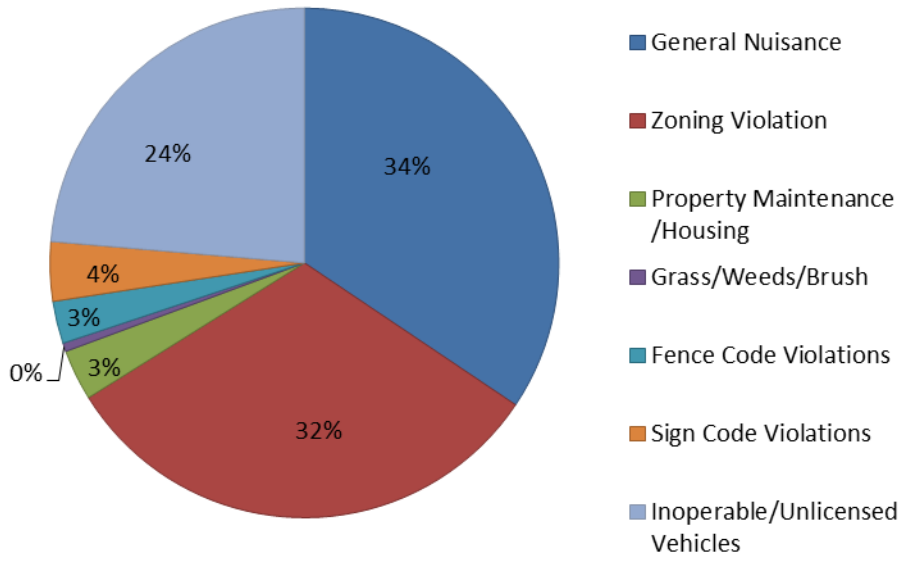

During the month of December, Code Enforcement staff focused enforcement efforts on illegal storage of Recreational Vehicles, with a total of 41 violations cited. During the previous 11 months of 2017, a total of 61 RV storage violations were cited. The following case load was managed by Code Enforcement staff during the month of December:

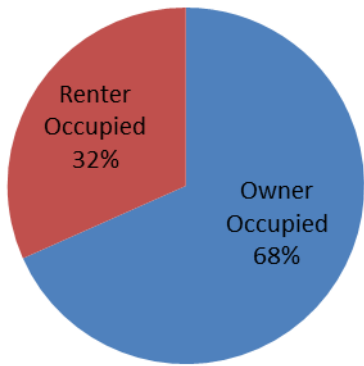

Of the 186 new cases created by staff, the breakdown by type is as follows:

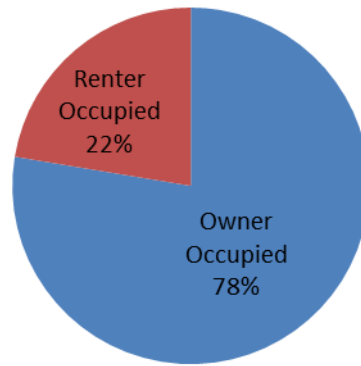

Inoperable/Unlicensed Vehicles	44



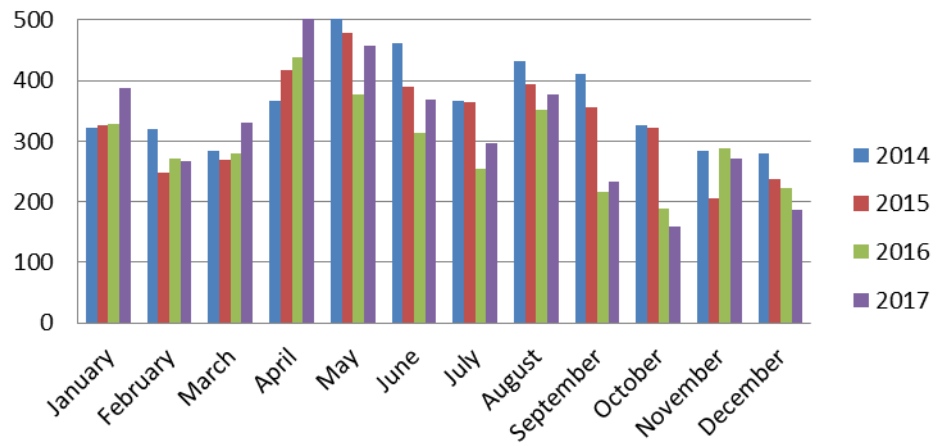
**Violations by Occupancy Type
